



# APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS BINGO

## INTRODUCTION:

We all know that April showers bring May flowers, but that doesn't mean the rainy April days should stop you from having fun in the classroom! Use this Spring vocabulary BINGO printable activity to brighten up your student's day.

## OBJECTIVES:

Students will learn Spring vocabulary terms throughout the game.

## GRADE LEVEL(S):

K-4

## MATERIALS:

Chips or markers to cover the words on the boards, copy of the BINGO board and word list

## HOW TO PLAY:

Step One: Have students fill their boards with words of their choice out of the list on the last page. Make sure they use a variety of different words. Help them write the words, if needed.

Step Two: Once their boards are filled, it's time to play! Randomly choose words from the list and mark them once they have been called.

Final Step: Like any other BINGO game, the first person to cover five spots in a row on their board and says "bingo" wins!
