LESSON FOCUS AND GOALS:

STRUCTURE / ACTIVITY:

THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITY IS DESIGNED FOR STUDENTS TO REFLECT ON THE PAST SCHOOL YEAR AND TO SHARE ANY TIPS, TRICKS, OR ADVICE FOR THE UPCOMING CLASS. STUDENTS MUST WRITE AT LEAST ONE SUGGESTION FOR EACH LETTER OF THE ALPHABET.

TO START THIS ACTIVITY, YOU MAY HAVE TO SHARE AN EXAMPLE WITH THE CLASS TO GET THEIR IDEAS FLOWING. FOLLOW THE EXAMPLES BELOW WITH THE CLASS IF THEY GET STUCK.

ONCE EACH STUDENT COMPLETES THE ACTIVITY, HAVE THEM SHARE THEIR ANSWERS AND THEN COLLECT THEIR PACKET FROM THEM. SAVE EACH PACKET TO SHARE WITH THE INCOMING CLASS ON THE FIRST DAY BACK TO SCHOOL POST-SUMMER VACATION.
